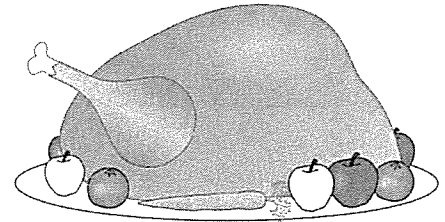

IN THE NEWS

Treasure Hunter Found Medieval Cross in Farm Field

UK - A nurse found a 500-year-old silver and gold crucifix while metal detecting in a farmer's field in Lancashire. Matthew Hepworth, 35, found the medieval silver gilt cross and pendant while searching for treasure in hamlet north of Lancaster last December. Preston Coroners' Court carried out an inquest on Friday to discover if the rare find really can be classified as treasure. The registered nurse, who lives in Morecambe, told Deputy Coroner Simon Jones that the artefact was the most "rare" thing he had found in 20 years as a metal detecting hobbyist. He said: "It really was a lovely find. I have always been interested in history and got my first metal detector when I was 15. "Over the years I have found a few things of note, including some Viking silver around 10 years ago. But I've never found anything like this." To qualify as treasure, an item must be at least 300-years-old and must contain more than 10% precious metal. The find was first reported to Lancaster Museum and later inspected by the British Museum. Experts at the museum said the 35mm by 26mm crucifix, which depicts a scroll over the figure of Christ, dated from between the 14th and 15th centuries and was made from gold and silver. Deputy coroner Simon Jones declared the find as treasure and said he hoped it would one day be displayed at a local museum. It is now property of the Crown. *Courtesy of <http://www.lep.co.uk>*
